

CASTLEGREGORY GOLF LINKS



LOCAL RULES TO BE READ IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE RULES OF GOLF

1. Out of Bounds: Beach, Boundary Fences (Do Not Cross), Car Park and Road into Car Park and Course.
2. Stakes or lines; Red-Lateral Water Hazard; Yellow-Water Hazard: Blue/White - GUR
3. Free Drop (one Clublength) from all roads, and paths with artificial surfaces, all sleepers/woodwork used to edge pathways, tees and steps, Bridges over hazards excepted.
4. All bridges that are inside the line of the Yellow or Red Water/Lateral hazard markers are in the hazard. All stakes and lines marking hazards are in the hazard. Play the ball as it lies or drop under penalty.
5. Free Drop (one clublength) from all GUR, freshly sodded areas (compulsory drop) to nearest point of relief.
6. The stakes, ropes, signs, water fittings etc. on the course are immovable obstructions. Rule 24.4. You may obtain relief if the obstruction interferes with your stance or intended swing by dropping back one club length. No Penalty. Sprinkler Heads situated two club-lengths from the Putting Green and within two club-lengths of the ball interferes on the line of play between the ball and the hole the player may take relief as follows: The ball must be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay that: (a) not nearer the hole; (b) not in a hazard or on a putting green.
7. Caution! For stock control purposes electric fences may be used on boundary fences.
8. Entry into Environmentally Sensitive Area (across rope) 9/18 (pond) strictly forbidden. Penalty: Automatic Disqualification. If there is a doubt whether a ball is in the E.S.A. or outside the E.S.A. a Player may play a provisional ball from the teebox or where last hit from or point of entry to the hazard.

Always check notice board for temporary rules.

3th, 5th & 7th Call Through Holes

Green Top Fairway markers are 150 metres from centre of green, red markers are 100 metres from centre of green.

Be tidy. Don't delay. Rake Bunkers...replace rake centre of Bunker. Replace Divots. Repair Pitch-Marks.

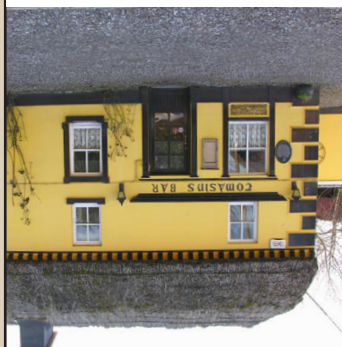

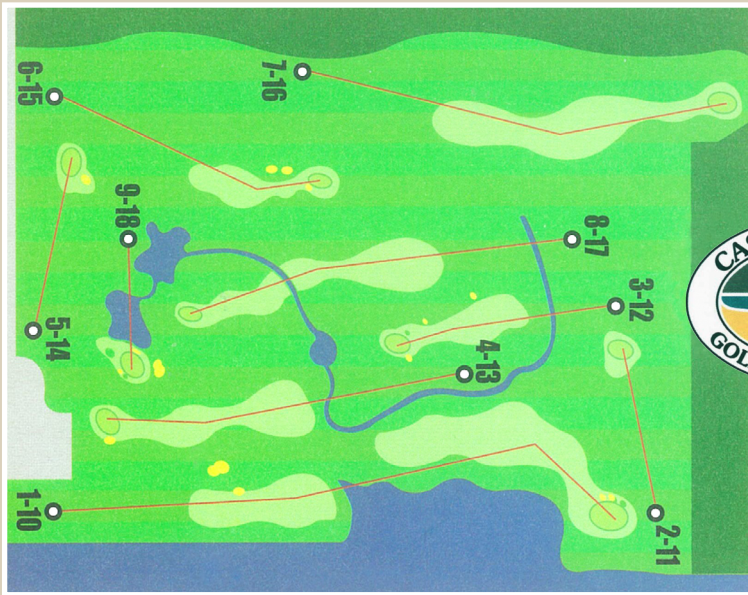
